DATE	READING	ACTIVITY
Dec 1	Luke 1:26-28	Discuss how you would feel if an angel suddenly appeared to you
Dec 2	Luke 1:29-33	Hang a mistletoe and give out kisses (real/chocolate)
Dec 3	Luke 1:34-35	Make paper snowflakes and hang them around your house
Dec 4	Luke 1:36-38	Do something for your church (offer to clean toys, take a pastor out for lunch, make treats for the staff, etc.)
Dec 5	Luke 1:39-45	Discuss if you have ever made a promise to someone. Did you keep that promise?
Dec 6	Luke 2:1-3	Sing, Dance, play Christmas music and worship our Savior
Dec 7	Luke 2:4-5	Make a family tree
Dec 8	Luke 2:6-7	Purchase or make a blanket and bring to a local non profit such as the Teddy Bear Den
Dec 9	Luke 2:8-9	Scan the QR code
Dec 10	Luke 2:10-11	Make a birthday cake for Jesus and sing to him
Dec 11	Luke 2:12	Scan the QR code
Dec 12	Luke 2:13-14	Sing Christmas Carols in your neighborhood
Dec 13	Luke 2:15-16	Talk about a time you have been so excited about something that you couldn't wait to see what it was
Dec 14	Luke 2:17-18	Play the 'telephone' game as a family
Dec 15	Luke 2:19	Make ice ornaments (color water, put it into mold of any shape, add trinkets, add a string out the top) and display them outside in a tree
Dec 16	Luke 2:20-21	Make cookies as a family and deliver to your neighbors with a note saying 'Jesus is Born'
Dec 17	Matthew 2:1-4	Look at a map and see where Bethlehem is
Dec 18	Matthew 2:5-8	Color the snow! Combine food coloring and water in a spray bottle and make some fun designs in the snow!
Dec 19	Matthew 2:9-10	Make a star using 6 popsicle sticks (make two triangles and put them together to make a 6-sided star)
Dec 20	Matthew 2:11	Visit a live nativity or play with a nativity at home
Dec 21	Romans 3:22-23	What does it mean to sin?
Dec 22	Romans 5:8	Candy Cane experiment (3 mason jars, mini candy canes, ice water, room temp water, boiling water) When we are 'hot or on fire' for Jesus he washes our sins away, just like the hot water washes the red away from the candy cane
Dec 23	Romans 10:9	Watch a Christmas movie together
Dec 24	Luke 1:26-45	Talk about the best gift you ever received and how Jesus will always be the best gift we have ever been given. Without Him, we wouldn't be here to enjoy God's earth
Dec 25	Luke 2:1-21	Write a thank you note to Jesus telling Him of all the amazing things He has blessed you with
